For this assignment you will create a space Webquest for another student. This Webquest should cover asteroids, comets, and meteors/meteorites. You will use Microsoft Word or another word document program to create this Webquest. Attach it and email it with all the rest of your group work!

To receive full credits your Webquest should contain the following:

3-5 Web pages as resources (not used previously in class)
20 questions
Questions pertaining to asteroids, comets, and meteors/meteorites.
Easy to use format.

Helpful Hints:

Keep word in a minimized window or use your iPad to find the sites.
Copy and paste addresses to Word.
Find fun Websites with activities.
Use search keywords such as: middle school science, comet, asteroid, meteors and meteorites, near-earth objects, orbit, etc.
